This hike requires a major effort just to get to the remote trailhead in the backcountry along the park's River Road. The trail crosses open desert before steadily ascending the western flanks of Mariscal Mountain, eventually leading you to a 1,400 foot limestone precipice. You can see and hear the Rio far below.
